Role-play (příprava na 4. část ÚZ)

In part 4 of your speaking part of the school leaving examination you will make a dialogue with your teacher on a given topic. You should show your fluency in speech, i.e. how you can keep the conversation going. Here is some advice how to do it:

- 1) Don't answer yes or no. Try to add some information in order to make it more interesting for your partner. Give reasons for your answers.
- 2) Give your opinion and ask your partner what he/she thinks or make a suggestion.
- 3) Ask questions.
- 4) React to your partner's ideas. Show that you are interested in what your partner is saying.
- 5) Don't let the conversation stop.
- 6) Try to make the conversation like a natural.
- 7) In the end you and your partner should come to an agreement.

Here are some useful phrases:

What do you think?

I'm not sure.

It's not bad.

I really like it.

I am not very keen on it.

It's absolutely fantastic.

I think it's great.

Yes, I agree.

I suppose so.
